\*Students entering the 9th grade in 2006 must pass 3 out of 5 required Regents with a 65 or above.

\*Students entering the 9th grade in 2007 must pass 4 out of 5 required Regents with a 65 or above.

Regents Diploma (Student must score a 65 or above on the five required Regents below.)

Students entering the 9th grade in 2008 must pass 5 out of 5 required Regents with a 65 or above.

The Local Diploma is no longer an option for General Education students and Career and Technical Education students.
